## Minutes for the Baroda Township Budget Workshop 1/20/2022

The Baroda Township Board met January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at the Municipal Buildings Meeting room at 9091 First St., for the purpose of reviewing and working on the Proposed Budget for 2022-2023, for the General Fund and Library Fund. The meeting was called at 6:00pm, Present were Board Members, Larry Klug(non-voting but present by call in), Dennis Krotzer, William Hurst, David Wolf and Christina Price. There was 1 Audience Member.

First on the agenda was the Zoning Administration Position. Supervisor Dennis Krotzer reported that he and the Clerk called references on both candidates and received positive feedback on both. Clerk Price mentioned that the pricing for the zoning application fees could go from \$35 to \$65 and the Zoning Administrator would receive 80% of all application fees and 20% of all Special Land Use Applications. After further discussion Supervisor Dennis Krotzer made a motion to appoint Ryan Keough as the Townships Zoning Administrator, supported by David Wolf. Vote All Yes. Motion Carried.

Supervisor Dennis Krotzer also mentions that the Maintenance Department could use a salt spreader that would be attached to the hitch. There was concern from Larry Klug that it could rust the truck out. To be discussed at a later date.

**Budget Workshop-** The Board Members worked on the Proposed Budget for 2022-2023 for General Fund and the Library Fund. The Board agreed to give increases to the Trustees Salary from \$315 to \$327.71 and meeting per diems from \$40 to \$50, Treasurer Salary will increase from \$16,000.00 to \$18,000.00, Supervisors Salary will increase from \$28,000.00 to \$35,000.00, Assessors Salary increase from \$16,170.00 to \$17,000.00, Clerks Salary will be revisited as there was disagreement from David Wolf on the 4% salary increase, Planning Commission Chair and Secretary Salaries will be increased to \$375 and Planning Commissioner meeting per diems will go from \$40 to \$50 per meeting, Ordinance Officers hourly pay will be increase from \$25 to \$30, Election Workers hourly pay increases from \$10 to \$12 and Chair will raise from \$11 to \$13. After further discussion there will be another Budget workshop to finish going over the General Fund and any other funds if time permits on February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 6:00pm
