Board Meeting Minutes
September 5th, 2024
Special Meeting

The Baroda Township Board met on Thursday, September 5th, 2024 at 9091 First St., in the Municipal Buildings meeting room, Baroda. Present were Board Members William Hurst, David Wolf, Dennis Krotzer, Larry Klug and Christina Price. There were 1 audience members. The meeting was opened at 6:30pm with a recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

New Business –

T-Mobile Grant – Christina Price presented a grant opportunity from T-Mobile for up to \$50,000. She would like to apply that towards Hess Lake Park improvements of a new toddler playset and enclosing the Old Pavilion. Quotes were discussed. After further discussion Dennis Krotzer made a motion to approve Christina Price to apply for this Grant as discussed, supported by William Hurst. Fire Department Land – Dennis Krotzer presented an idea to look further into the property on Cleveland next to Dollar General to purchase. After further discussion William Hurst made a motion to approve spending up to \$10,000 on a site plan from Wightman to see if the property would work for a new Fire Station, as long as the purchase of the land was the same as discussed, supported by David Wolf. Cemetery Funeral Home Pricing - This was briefly discussed and will be discussed further at the next regular Board Meeting.

Rubbish- After further discussion David Wolf made a motion to approve increasing the rubbish assessment to \$230 per unit, supported by Larry Klug. By Roll Call Vote – Voting Yes; William Hurst, David Wolf, Dennis Krotzer, Larry Klug and Christina Price. Voting No, None. Motion Carried
