Upon the official dissolution of the Village, the Michigan Department of Treasury must receive the legal documentation confirming the dissolution. Once this documentation is received, the village's population and all related revenue sharing factors (including taxable value and millage rates) would be incorporated into the values of the township(s) in which the village is located. The revised township(s) revenue sharing factors would then be used in any future revenue sharing payment calculations.
