RENEWAL OF FIRE EQUIPMENT FUND MILLAGE

For the purpose of operating the Fire Equipment Fund and providing emergency fire services within Baroda Township shall the expired previously voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution of .9981 mills (\$.9981 for each \$1,000 of real and personal property subject to taxation in Baroda Township, including the Village of Baroda) reduced to .9773 mills by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and increased to .9981 mills (\$.9981 for each \$1,000 of real and personal property subject to taxation). Said millage, if approved by the electors of Baroda Township, will be levied for a period of four (4) years, starting in 2027 and ending in 2030. It is estimated that the levy will generate \$136,500.00 in the first year.

**RENEWAL OF PUBLIC SAFETY MILLAGE TO FUND BARODA TOWNSHIP
POLICE SERVICES**

In support of the continued operation of the Baroda-Lake Police Department, and in order to provide police services to Baroda Township residents, shall the expired previously voted increase in the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed under Article IX, Sec.6 of the Michigan Constitution against the taxable valuation of all real and personal property in Baroda Township liable for taxation, including that land and personal property lying in the Village of Baroda, be renewed at 3.2399 mills (\$3.2399 per \$1,000 taxable valuation, as equalized).

The authorization to levy said millage is for a period of four (4) years, being the years of 2027 through 2030. It is estimated that the amount of revenue to be generated from the total millage in the first year of levy in 2027 will be approximately \$442,636.34. YES NO

**INCREASE OF PUBLIC SAFETY MILLAGE TO FUND BARODA
TOWNSHIP POLICE SERVICES**

In support of the continued operation of the Baroda-Lake Police Department, and in order to provide police services to Baroda Township residents, shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution against the taxable valuation of all real and personal property in Baroda Township liable for taxation, including that land and personal property lying in the Village of Baroda, be increased by 1.3601 mills (\$1.3601 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation, as equalized). The authorization to levy said millage is for a period of four (4) years, being the years of 2027 through 2030. It is estimated that the amount of revenue to be generated from the 1.3601-mills increase in the first year of levy will be approximately \$186,447.03. YES NO
