- **Old Pavilion Doors** – Dennis Krotzer reported that the doors are in and should be getting installed soon.
- **Disincorporation Commission** – Dennis Krotzer and Christina Price spoke about posting what fact findings have been gathered so far to post on the Townships website for the residents to review items while the Disincorporation Commission is still not formed. There was additional discussion from the Township Treasurer, William Hurst asking what it would take for the Township Supervisor, Dennis Krotzer to appoint the third Commissioner. There were many audience comments and concerns related to this conversation.

### New Business –

- **Minutes Correction from January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026 meeting** – Clerk, Christina Price commented that there is a correction that needed to note for the January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026 meeting minutes for the attendance. It should have stated that David Wolf was present and Larry Klug was joined by phone and no voting.
- **Road Department Agreement** – Dennis Krotzer reported that he signed the Road Department Agreement for Gray Rd and Jayme Dr for Scratch and Seal Road project for 2026 for a total cost of \$142,814.29. The Townships portion will be \$111,274.29.
