Board Meeting Minutes
April 15th, 2026

The Baroda Township Board met on Monday April 15th, 2026 at 9091 First St., in the Municipal Buildings meeting room, Baroda. Present were Board Members William Hurst, David Wolf, Dennis Krotzer, Larry Klug and Christina Price. There were 19 Audience members. The meeting was opened at 6:00pm with a recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

New Business –

- **Proposed Fire Station Design and Estimate:** Treasurer William Hurst gave a recap about the Fire Department Committee that was formed to help design a new Fire Station. William Hurst mentioned they received the quote back from Wightman for \$7.2 million and would like to set another meeting with Wightman to see how they can scale the building down. There was also discussion about focusing on the November Election, instead of August to have the Fire Station Millage on the ballot. David Wolf talked about the scaling the Fire Station by decreasing the meeting room size and removing a fire truck bay. It was also discussed to get the residents feedback on the design. Christina Price mentioned using Brooks Architecture firm or a different firm to compare pricing, it was discussed and mentioned that it would not change the cost by changing firms. After further discussion David Wolf made a motion to approve spending \$5,825.00 for the additional service by Wightman to revise the fire station drawings and documents, supported by Larry Klug. By Roll Call Vote – Voting Yes; David Wolf, William Hurst, Dennis Krotzer, Larry Klug, Christina Price. Voting No, None. Motion Carried
